Another Delay for the DEIS

There has been yet another delay for release of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area.

The document had been expected "*late December or early January*" according to previous statements by Superintendent Mike Murray.

The DEIS is going to be an important document in the sequence of events for the National Park Service to finalize a long-term management plan affecting the future of beach access in the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area.

According to a recent report in the Island Free Press, Mike Murray now says, the "*exact release date is still undetermined. Based on what I am hearing about the status, I would characterize it as soon*

(as within the next month or so)"
