NEWS UPDATE

In an interview today, National Park Service Superintendent Mike Murray, said the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area is in the final stages of preparation. Murray said he expects the DEIS to be released, ***“Late December or early January.”***

As soon as the DEIS is released, Dare County and others will study it immediately and make recommendations based upon which alternative best utilizes science to manage wildlife resources and provide reasonable access.
